

# Meeker County Fair TRACTOR PULL General Rules

Thursday, July 30, 2026 @ 7:00 PM

Registration starts @ 4:00 PM



1. All drivers under the age of 18 must have their parents' written permission. Parents assume all responsibility.
2. Drivers must remain seated during the entire pull and always have full control of the vehicle. No chain jerking or hot rodding allowed.
3. All drivers must attend a meeting prior to the start of the pull.
4. Consumption of alcohol by drivers or pit crew is NOT allowed. Anyone caught in possession of or consuming alcohol before or during the competition will be immediately disqualified.
5. Judges' decisions are final. Failure to obey track officials will result in disqualification.
6. Tractors must stay within the boundaries of the track. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
7. Loss of any weights and/or parts under the green flag during the pull will result in disqualification.
8. All tractors must be neutral or parked when hooked or unhooked, placing hands in the air while being hooked.
9. All pullers must furnish their own 3 ½ inch clevis or 3 ½ inch hole.
10. Hitch height maximum of twenty (20) inches and hitch length no less than eighteen (18) inches from the center of the rear axle. Hitch must be solid in all directions. Pulling from two or three points is not allowed.
11. All pullers may only have a second attempt, provided they stop before 100 feet.
12. All tractors in classes 6,500 and under must have a factory stock motor, manifold, carburetor or injection pump and drive train for that make and model. No downdraft carburetors unless factory. No block spacers.  
Governors are required.
13. Maximum tire size up to and including are as follows. Radial tires are allowed.

14. Cut tires will be allowed on the King of the Hill classes and Top Cut (6mph) classes on track 2.
15. Each tractor can be pulled up to three (3) times:
  - Option 1: Three (3) stock classes
  - Option 2: Two (2) stock classes and one (1) King of the Hill. May pull King of the Hill only.
16. \$25.00 per hook; one (1) pit pass per driver and one (1) pit person with first \$25 entry fee.
17. No part of the tractor may interfere with the sled during the pull. Front weights and support frame must be a maximum of eleven (11) feet from the center of the rear axle. Weights must be safely secured.
18. All tractors must have working rear brakes.
19. Only one (1) type of fuel per tractor. No Water.
20. No turbos allowed on 8,500 and down.
21. One hundred (100) pound grace.
22. Four (4) MPH speed limit on track 1 for 3,500# -7,500# class, six (6) MPH speed limit on Top Cut classes. No speed limit on track 2 for 7,500# + tractor classes.
23. Strongly Recommended: Wheelie bars, Rops or cabs required on all tractors.

## **PAYOUT:**

### **Track 1:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive a trophy and 30% cash from entry fees.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place will receive a trophy, 20% cash from entry fees.
- 1<sup>st</sup> place King of the Hill will receive a trophy and \$100.00 cash payout.

### **Track 2:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive a trophy, 30% Cash, and \$150
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place will receive a trophy, 20% Cash, and \$75
