RULES: *An animal CANNOT compete in both 4-H and FFA.

OPEN CLASS ENTRIES

PRE-REGISTER: All Open Class animals must PRE-REGISTER by JULY 19 in order to earn PREMIUM

IDENTIFICATION/HEALTH

IDENTIFICATION: All sheep entering the fairgrounds must have an official Scrapie ID or a registered tattoo along with a breed registry number. All animals will be checked upon arrival. Any animal without proper identification will be required to leave the fairgrounds, and the animal will not be eligible for competition or premium.

***Proper identification outlined on pages 22-25.**

HEALTH CHECK: All sheep will be examined by veterinarian.

ANIMAL ARRIVAL

PENNING: Anyone bringing sheep to the fair (4-H, FFA, Open) needs to inform a superintendent by **JULY 19** so proper penning can be arranged.

ARRIVAL TIME: Sheep are allowed onto the fairgrounds starting on Wednesday, July 30. Sheep must be in place by 7:00 AM on Thursday, July 31.

RELEASE TIME: Sheep will be released no sooner than **6:30 PM on Sunday.**

TRAILERS: All livestock trailers must enter the fairgrounds through the **North Gate**. When leaving the grounds, trailers can exit through the **South Gate** or the **Northwest Gate** (see map).

***Trailers can park behind East side of the Grandstand (follow gravel road back to the end and park behind Sheriff's Building in mowed area.)**
