

# Meeker County Fairgrounds Tractor/Truck Pull Rules

Thursday, August 4, 2022 @ 7:00 PM, Registration starts @ 4:00 PM

1. All drivers under the age of 18 must have a parent's written permission. Parents assume all responsibility.
2. Drivers must remain seated during the entire pull and always have full control of the vehicle.
3. All drivers must attend a meeting prior to the start of the pull.
4. Consumption of alcohol by drivers or pit crew is not allowed. Anyone caught in possession of or consuming alcohol before or during the competition will be immediately disqualified.
5. Judges' decisions are final. Failure to obey track officials will result in disqualification.
6. Tractors and trucks must stay within the boundaries of the track. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
7. Loss of any weights and/or parts under the green flag during the pull will result in disqualification.
8. All tractors and trucks must be in neutral or park when being hooked or unhooked.
9. All pullers must furnish their own 3 ½ inch clevis or 3 ½ inch hole.
10. Hitch height maximum of twenty (20) inches and hitch length no less than eighteen (18) inches from the center of the rear axle. Hitch must be solid in all directions. Pulling from two or three points is not allowed.
11. Hitch height maximum of twenty-six (26) inches for trucks.
12. No first pull re-pull option.
13. All tractors in classes 6,500 and under must be 1959 or older and have a factory stock motor, manifold, carburetor or injection pump and drive train for that make and model. No downdraft carburetors unless factory. No block spacers. Governors required.
14. 10% over factory on RPMS.
15. Cut tires will be allowed on open class tractors only.
16. Each tractor can be pulled up to three (3) times:
  - Option 1: Three (3) stock classes
  - Option 2: Two (2) stock classes and one (1) King of the Hill.
17. \$25.00 per hook; one (1) pit pass per hook.
18. No part of the tractor/truck may interfere with the sled during the pull. Front weights and support frame must be a maximum of eleven (11) feet from the center of the rear axle. Weights must be safely secured.
19. All tractors/trucks must have working rear brakes.
20. Only one (1) type of fuel per tractor.
21. No turbos allowed on 8,500 and down.
22. One hundred (100) pounds grace.
23. Four (4) MPH speed limit on 3,500 – 6,500 class. No speed limit on 6,500 street gas truck and 7,000+ tractor class.

## **PAYOUT:**

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Class 1 and Class 2 will receive a trophy and 50% cash payout.

1<sup>st</sup> place winner of King of the Hill will receive \$100.00 cash payout.
