## **OPEN CLASS RULES**

- 1. No more than one entry per lot.
- 2. Each exhibitor is requested to bring their own display plates.
- Plates of apples must consist of exactly 4 specimens. Crab or hybrid, 8 specimens. EACH VARIETY CORRECTLY LABELED WITH NAME.
- Exhibitors may replace with fresh fruit, any specimen that shows a tendency to spot or decay at any time during the fair, except when the judges are working on the class to which it belongs.
- Decayed, injured or inferior specimens must not be exhibited, and when such specimens appear in a collection, the entire exhibit may be disqualified.
- 6. When the number of competitors in any lot is less than the number of awards offered, the judges may, at their discretion, award the lower prizes, omitting the higher ones; but premiums will not be awarded on inferior collections or specimens, even if there is no competition.
- Overgrown specimens are not desirable. Select specimens normal and uniform in size, color and quality. Name of fruit to be displayed on exhibit.
- The superintendent will provide uniform label cards and see that they are properly attached to all fruit and vegetable entries. Name variety, if possible.
