## OPEN CLASS RULES

1. No more than one entry per lot.
2. Each exhibitor is requested to bring their own display plates.
3. Plates of apples must consist of exactly 4 specimens. Crab or hybrid, 8 specimens. EACH VARIETY CORRECTLY LABELED WITH NAME.
4. Exhibitors may replace with fresh fruit, any specimen that shows a tendency to spot or decay at any time during the fair, except when the judges are working on the class to which it belongs.
5. Decayed, injured or inferior specimens must not be exhibited, and when such specimens appear in a collection, the entire exhibit may be disqualified.
6. When the number of competitors in any lot is less than the number of awards offered, the judges may, at their discretion, award the lower prizes, omitting the higher ones; but premiums will not be awarded on inferior collections or specimens, even if there is no competition.
7. Overgrown specimens are not desirable. Select specimens normal and uniform in size, color and quality. Name of fruit to be displayed on exhibit.
8. The superintendent will provide uniform label cards and see that they are properly attached to all fruit and vegetable entries. Name variety, if possible.
