- TIME:** 6:00 PM

- FORMAT:** FFA & Open Class Shows take place simultaneously

- RULES:** *An animal that competes in the 4-H Show CANNOT compete in FFA, but it can compete in Open Class. Likewise, an animal that competes in the FFA Show can also compete in Open Class, but NOT the 4-H Show.

OPEN CLASS ENTRIES

IDENTIFICATION/HEALTH

IDENTIFICATION TAGS: All cattle entering the fairgrounds must have proper identification tags. All animals will be checked upon arrival. Any animal without proper identification will be required to leave the fairgrounds, and the animal will not be eligible for competition or premium.

*Proper identification outlined on pages 29-31.

HEALTH CHECK: All cattle will be examined by the official veterinarian. NO WARTS or RINGWORM allowed.

ANIMAL ARRIVAL

STALLING: Anyone bringing cattle to the fair (4-H, FFA, Open Class) needs to inform a superintendent by **JULY 23** so proper stalling can be arranged.

BEDDING: Bedding fee charged per head. Exhibitors must pay superintendent as soon as cattle enter barn.

*Price determined on availability

ARRIVAL TIME: Cattle are allowed onto the fairgrounds starting on Wednesday, Aug. 3. Cattle must be in place by 7:00 AM on Thursday, Aug. 4.

RELEASE TIME: Beef cattle will be released no sooner than **6:00 PM on Sunday.**

TRAILERS: All livestock trailers must enter the fairgrounds through the **North Gate**. When leaving the grounds, trailers can exit through the **South Gate** or the **Northwest Gate** (see map).

*Trailers can park in field across from the West Gate during the fair for no charge.
